Come and join us for a fun day shopping with Lucky Door Prizes and raffles. Bring a friend along and enjoy a day out and do some early Christmas shopping!

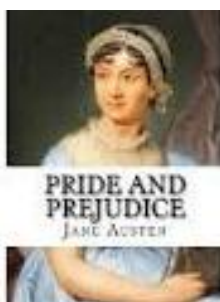

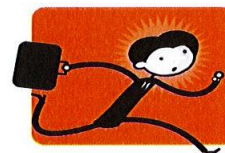
