Congratulations to Mrs Cox-Barlow for completing her Anti Racist Contact Officer (ARCO) course this week. Under the Department's Anti-Racism Policy each school is required to have a trained Anti-Racism Contact Officer.

What is the role of the ARCO

The Anti-Racism Contact Officer does not investigate complaints of racism. The ARCO has a mediation, procedural, educational and monitoring role.

Any concerns held by parents/carers or students regarding racism should be directed to the principal who will consult with the ARCO.

2018 Enrolments

We continue to grow in enrolments and at this point in time, our enrolments for 2018 will be 71 students, which is just 7 short of a fourth classroom teacher entitlement, (enrolment of 78 students entitles a school to a 4th classroom teacher).
