Coaches Needed!!!!

If the Active After School program is to be sustainable in our school, it is necessary that we have community members willing to become coaches. This would involve a one day training course and a short online course. All the activities are prepared for you and this makes the program very simple to run. Coaches are paid a minimum of \$40 each session. The commitment would be for 7 sessions in a school term. It may be that you are involved for one term each year. It is entirely flexible.

If you think this might be something you could be involved in please return the expression of interest attached to the newsletter to the school office and we can then connect you with the program organisers.

Please consider this if you have ever coached a sport, have knowledge about a particular sport, have an interest in earning some extra cash. There is always a staff member on duty to organise the students and support you during the session.

Music Tuition Term 1, 2013

We ask that you advise the school via the **Expression of Interest** whether your child will be **continuing with private music lessons** in Term 1, 2013 **OR** whether your child would like to **participate for the first time** in this program.

We currently have 11 students involved in this program with tuition delivered by Miss A on Thursdays and Fridays for 30 minutes of individual instruction per student.

Tuition could be in guitar, saxophone, clarinet, piano or recorder.
