After the postponement of Apple Day and the AGM in 2020, TCFG proposes to hold an AGM in July and stage, a community-centred Apple Day event in spring.

An additional sculpture is about to be installed in the Park depicting Deputy Surveyor James Meehan commemorating his 1818 survey through Tallong lands. As well as improving Hall facilities, the application submitted to the Country Resilience Grant scheme is to provide funds to add a multipurpose gym to the Park and for the clearing and seeding of the Tourist and Recreation Reserve. The TCFG has reached the second round of a Federal Volunteers Grant scheme, giving TCFG technical support for record-keeping, communications, and organization of events.
