Tallong Apple Day 2019 – This was a reported issue with the police, and we have been advised not to discuss. Tallong Apple Day 2022 – Successful Day, very expensive day with all expenses much more than pre covid. Tallong Apple Day 2023 - The next council clean-up day is scheduled for Apple Day 2023. Chrissy will contact Council and ask them to reconsider as this will cause significant disruption to the Apple Day traffic plan.

Goulburn Council Community Grants

Amy Croker from Council will send a list of grants that we have received from council.

The skate park went way over budget due to drainage issues.

The grant to renovate the memorial hall is underway. The access door to the "supper room" as well as the internal access to the main hall will be widened to enable disabled access. The bathrooms will be renovated as well as the kitchen area to ensure meets council regulations. Walkways will be completed to allow access to the handicapped toilet.

The skate park should be completed before Christmas as well as the installation of 2 picnic benches.

The installation of a shipping container onsite for storage of Apple Day Inventory has been raised with Goulburn Mulwaree Council and we are awaiting approval from council. To be followed up asap.

War Memorial

Discussion on restoration of the mortar at the War Memorial. This will go ahead if grant application is successful as well as remodel, replant the garden surrounding.

Community Christmas Party

The Community Christmas Party has been cancelled due to the groundwork being carried out in the park. We will plan a community BBQ in January/February to coincide with the opening of the skate park.

Community Newsletter

Agreement has been made that the Community newsletter will be delivered with Australia Post via the new mail contractor who is starting 1st December. Will aim for community newsletter to be published quarterly. The Community newsletter will be uploaded to the TCFG website.

Community Garden

The community Garden is maintained by a very small group of volunteers. We need to plan for a community working bee as it has become quite overgrown due to the rain.

Tallong Hall Trust

Discussed the connection between Tallong Community Focus Group and the Tallong Hall Trust. The Tallong Hall is run by a Trust, not GM Council. This enables running costs to be kept at a minimum. Need to upgrade aircon, fridges and hot water system to keep electricity costs down.

Cricket Ground

The cricket ground is earmarked to have a revamp however needs to have a soil contamination check first.

"The Pot"

Discussed renovation of "The Pot". Will approach Boral to asphalt the surrounding area to create a car parking area and to repaint. Need to do this asap.
